

Constitution of "District Electricity Committees" under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY) And Integrated Power development Scheme (IPDS)

PREAMBLE:

The Ministry of Power, Government of India has introduced two Schemes namely the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY) and Integrated Power development Scheme (IPDS) for rural and urban areas respectively. The main aims of DDUGJY are feeder separation, strengthening and augmentation of sub-transmission & distribution network, metering at all level in the rural areas and village electrification, while the main aims of IPDS are strengthening of sub-transmission & distribution network, metering of distribution transformers/feeders/consumers in the urban areas and IT enablement of distribution sector.

The underlying objective of these schemes is to ensure uninterrupted and reliable energy access to all. Detailed guidelines of these schemes require inter-alia, consultation with public representatives including Members of Parliament and each utility has to furnish a certificate to this effect while submitting DPRs to the Nodal Agencies declared by Govt. of India i.e. Rural Electrification Corporation for DDUGJY and Power Finance Corporation Ltd. for IPDS.

To institutionalize the system of consultation with public representatives, it is decided to form a District Level Committee in which the public representatives are actively engaged throughout the life cycle of the project from its formulation to execution and regular monitoring.

Accordingly the proposal of constitution of "District Electricity Committee" was under the consideration of the State Government.

Resolution:

After careful consideration, the Government of Gujarat is hereby decided to constitute the "District Electricity Committee" for each district to approve the Detailed Project Report (DPR) and also to review and monitoring the implementation of Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY) and Integrated Power development Scheme (IPDS) at District level.

The committee shall consist of the following members:

Concerned Collector of the District shall identify members of the committee for the district consisting the public representatives and District officials as mentioned in above paragraph.

Meeting of the District Electricity Committee shall convene every three months at District headquarter.

Functioning of the Committee like to convene the meeting in stipulated time period, to prepare agenda of the meeting, to bring certain issues related to monitoring and implementation of the schemes before the

Committee and to prepare minutes etc. shall be taken up by Superintending Engineer of energy Distribution Company of concerned district in consultation with the concerned District Collector.
